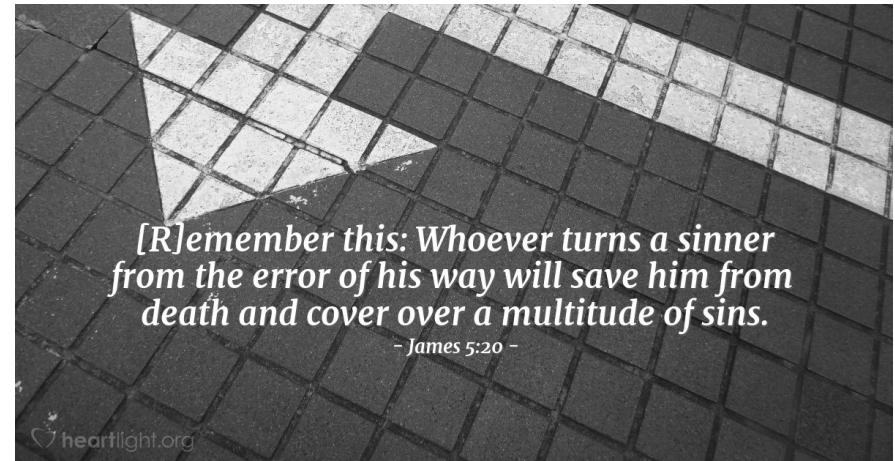
COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT:
